In addition, many of the other guys on the corner asked James to take them to the hospital so that they could visit their friend. This became a great opportunity for ministry throughout the week and for sharing Truth. On one occasion, James presented the

The Lord continues to open doors and provide opportunities for James to share Truth with many people here in our community as he mans his card table. The City of Minneapolis closed down the corner store and pulled its license. However, it is still owned by a man who professes Christ. So, by God's great grace, James continues to have a place to set up his table and get out His Word! Due to construction in the parking lot of the store, James moved the location of the table closer to the sidewalk on 26th Ave. N. This move has brought even more people to the table! Praise the Lord!

Many of the young men who consort on the corner have come over to the table and sat down with James. This gives him an opportunity to share a full gospel with them and to teach them different things about God. He has taught a number of them about God's image in man and the powers of the soul.

The Lord has used these past months of being a constant figure in the parking lot to build these relationships. Often these young men will come up to the table and greet James with a big hug! A number of them have even confided in him regarding their individual struggles. Even one of the hardest guys on the corner – not interested in conversation or a Word from the Lord – has recently begun to take tracts and actually sat down yesterday to hear about the image of God in man.

Not only has James had increased opportunities to minister to the young men from the gangs, the Lord has brought young women from the neighborhood to the table as regular visitors and recipients of tracts. He even brought a woman about to be a first-time mom who is seeking to return to the church along with her husband. We are so delighted to see His mighty hand move

among our neighbors! Remember, our desire is to begin a Bible Study here in the community this summer. Pray with us that this might be the Lord planting seeds in preparation for that.

We love these people that God has brought into our circle, and we desire to show them that love by holding out the image of Christ to them. Please pray with us that the Lord will show Himself to these folks and save many for His glory.

PRAYERFUL REMEMBERANCES

Our local City Councilman, Don Samuels, has orchestrated a practice of conducting prayer vigils at the murder locations here in our community. FELLOWSHIP & MENTORING ON THE INSIDE

Back in February, James completed training to be a volunteer for InnerChange Freedom Initiative (IFI). In the beginning of April he began a mentoring relationship with an inmate at Lino Lakes Prison.

IFI is a faith-based, transformational program developed by Prison Fellowship, the nation's largest Christian ministry to prisoners. Currently, there are four states — Texas, Iowa, Kansas and Minnesota — that have the IFI program operating within their correctional system.

According to IFI literature, "(The program) is based on the belief that real and lasting change happens from the inside out, as a person repents of sin, receives forgiveness and salvation through Christ and draws upon His mighty power day by day." The inmates who volunteer to be a part of IFI live in community with one another separate from the rest of the prison population and are steeped in biblical values 24/7. As a prisoner involved in the program nears the time of his release, he enters phase II which

includes 6 months of in-prison weekly mentoring sessions prior to release and 12 months of transition mentoring following release.

James met the man he is now mentoring last fall when he taught at the prison as part of the

workshops provided by our church, Bethlehem Baptist. He has been greatly blessed to be used of the Lord in this man's life thus far and is looking forward to see what the Lord will do as He continues to build their relationship.

For a couple of hours on Monday evenings the two meet and study the things of God, pray and

fellowship. James has been greatly encouraged by this man's desire and readiness to learn as well as witnessing the many fruits that the Lord has already developed in him. He is looking forward to a long friendship with this new, dear brother in the Lord. Please join us in praying for this man and his family and that James would be a source of encouragement to him pointing him to the only one who satisfies. Christ.
