Not long after they left, Nathan called with the names of three young men that they met just off of West Broadway who were receptive to their message of Jesus and who also took Bibles. Anne and Laura prayed for each person to receive a new heart and believe in Jesus for salvation. Between diaper changes, feedings and naps, phone calls continued to come in after each stop. "Joseph and Jeremiah, James had previously given him a ride to the hospital." "Bernard, Lovely and Carlos on the corner of Logan and W. Broadway." "Jeff, Joseph, Ed, Vanessa and Earl." At first Anne had been wondering just what this time of prayer would look like while the men were gone. Soon, she had her answer! Between the babies and the phone calls there wasn't much downtime. The ladies were praising the Lord for His faithfulness, grace, protection and love toward the lost and toward their families.

Upon their return about two hours later the men were overflowing with the joy of the Lord having been blessed by seeing the mighty hand of Jesus Christ at work in themselves and our community. They were able to distribute all 31 Bibles plus many more tracts reaching about fifty people in all that day. There were no negative incidents. In fact, the people they met were receptive to their message and for the most part thankful. Even those that didn't want to take any materials were kind in their refusals. Praise the Lord for His mercy and love! This time out among the broader community proved to be a great opportunity for James to begin building relationships with these young men and women. We have asked you in past newsletters to pray that the Lord would open a door for us to start a Bible Study in our home to reach the people in our community sometime this summer. Well, by God's grace, we've set a target date of Saturday, August 19th. We continue to beseech the Lord to bring this desire to fruition and would ask that you do the same.

By His great grace and mercy, He has opened a huge number of opportunities to set the stage for this study and even to begin ministering to the people of our community in a more in depth way at the Christ Satisfies Ministries evangelism table.

What began as an opportunity for James to simply hand out tracts, Bibles and other godly materials while encouraging the people taking them to look to the Lord has, in recent weeks, become a time of sharing with people and even

teaching some in a much greater degree. His table has two chairs and often the second is filled with a lost soul admitting his or her status as a sinner and listening soberly to both God's requirements and His glorious, indescribable gift, Jesus Christ.

Just this past week James has had the opportunity and privilege of presenting the full gospel to sixteen people as he sat at the table on the corner of Knox and 26th Ave. North! With a change in the dynamics of the corner – the store has been closed down by the City and the drug dealers seem to have relocated – witnessing opportunities have increased. We weren't certain what the Lord was doing when he took the store out of the picture. Would James still be able to set up his table? Would the ministry impact less people? These were just a few of our questions. Well, since James moved his table closer to the street, the number of people who come by and hear the gospel has greatly increased. In addition, the variety of people visiting the table are a broader representation of our community as a whole – kids, teenagers, the drug dealers & gangsters, young moms and many who drive by and stop for a Word from the Lord or a Bible. With the recent addition of a sign announcing "Free Bibles," people are pulling up and sending their children out to get the Word. Praise the Lord for

providing opportunities for His Word to reach people. Here are some of this week's highlights!

- Cedric a single dad with two children pulled over as he was driving down 26th Ave. "What are you selling?" he inquired. (Praise the Lord for His sense of humor in providing a great opening for an evangelist!) James told him that he was giving away Words from the Lord. Cedric acknowledged his need for that and quickly pulled into the parking lot. James went over to his car to deliver the Word, and the two spoke for a long time. Cedric shared some of his trials, struggles and needs. James was able by God's grace to listen with compassion, share the saving truth of Jesus and encourage Cedric to seek the Lord. He was quite open to the truth and even expressed a desire to go to church with his children on Sunday. James directed him to Bethlehem Baptist Church and gave him our phone number for future contact.
- Takeila was walking by with her two toddlers, Takeila and Keisha, and two of her friends, Danielle and Mary. They stopped at the table to inquire what James was doing. In turn, he shared the gospel with them pointing out their need for a Savior

utilizing the law to show them how far we all fall from God's perfect standard. They acknowledged their sin and lacking in God's sight. Each heard the truth and took materials pointing them to Christ and how to grow in a relationship with him upon salvation – prayer, daily Bible reading, church fellowship, etc.

- Mike stood at the table for quite sometime the other day and poured out his heart to James. He told of his past "good works" and his current trials and struggles. James shared the full gospel with him and challenged him to stop trying to work his way into heaven and surrender to the only Savior, Jesus Christ. Mike made a full confession of his sin, took a Bible and committed to reading the Book of John.

James is greatly blessed and humbled to be used by the Lord to present His glorious gospel of grace to the people he meets each week here in North Minneapolis. Please pray for the continued fruitfulness of this aspect of Christ Satisfies Ministries. Pray with us that the Lord might be pleased to use these many opportunities of sharing the gospel to plant seeds for the beginning of a community Bible Study later this summer.
